DESCRIPTION

Pressure screws are generally used to assemble and secure one object within another. The screw passes through a threaded hole in the outer object and is tightened against the inner object to prevent it from moving relative to the outer object. This type of screw is used to prevent relative motion between two rotating parts, such as the movement of a pulley on a shaft.
