### DESCRIPTION

#### Pocket screw without plating

Pocket-hole joinery, or pocket-screw joinery, involves drilling a hole at an angle (usually 15 degrees) into one workpiece, and then joining it to a second workpiece with a special screw. Clamping is not required. Glue is recommended, but not necessary.

### **ADVANTAGES AND BENEFITS**

The Type 17 point eliminates pre-drilling. It also prevents the wood from cracking and splitting. The regular thread provides reliable holding power, ensuring that the fastened components remain securely in place.
